PURPOSE

These Reservation Regulations are adopted by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma pursuant to Chapter 4 of the Intertribal Wildlife Code and the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact.

These regulations establish wildlife management requirements unique to the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma and supplement the Intertribal Wildlife Code. Unless specifically modified herein, all provisions of the Intertribal Wildlife Code remain in full force and effect within the boundaries of the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma Reservation.

SECTION 1

Authority

These Reservation Regulations are adopted by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma pursuant to Chapter 4 of the Intertribal Wildlife Code and the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact.

These regulations apply solely within the jurisdiction of the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma's Reservation.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as limiting or diminishing the inherent sovereign authority of the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2

Lands and Waters Covered

These Reservation Regulations apply to all lands and waters located within the boundaries of the Peoria Tribe's Reservation over which the Peoria Tribe exercises jurisdiction or wildlife management authority, including lands and waters owned, held in trust, restricted, leased, managed, or otherwise controlled by the Peoria Tribe.

Nothing in these Regulations shall be construed to regulate activities occurring outside the boundaries of the Peoria Tribe Reservation or on lands and waters over which the Peoria Tribe does not exercise jurisdiction or wildlife management authority, except as otherwise authorized by applicable federal law, the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact, or other lawful agreement.

SECTION 3

Reservation Access

Any person hunting, fishing, trapping, gathering, or otherwise participating in outdoor recreation activities within the Peoria Tribe Reservation shall:

1. Possess a valid hunting, fishing, trapping, or other applicable license issued by a federally recognized Tribal Nation that is a signatory to the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact.
2. Comply with the Intertribal Wildlife Code.
3. Comply with these Peoria Tribe Wildlife Regulations.
4. Comply with all applicable Peoria Tribe laws, regulations, and posted property restrictions.

Nothing contained in this section shall be construed as granting access to Peoria Tribe owned or managed properties.

SECTION 4

Peoria Tribe Property Access

The Peoria Tribe recognizes valid hunting, fishing, trapping, and other applicable licenses issued by federally recognized Tribal Nations participating in the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact.

However, the Peoria Tribe does not allow any person to enter, hunt, fish, trap, or gather on lands or waters owned, leased, managed, or otherwise controlled by the Peoria.

Possession of a valid license issued by a participating tribe **does not authorize entry onto Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma-owned or managed properties.**

Nothing contained in these Regulations or the Compact shall be interpreted as creating a public right of access to lands owned, leased, managed, or otherwise controlled by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma.

SECTION 5

Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma-Owned and Managed Properties

At the time of adoption of these Regulations, **the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma does not permit hunting on any lands or waters owned, leased, managed, or otherwise controlled by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma.**

Nothing contained within the Intertribal Wildlife Management and Reciprocity Compact, the Intertribal Wildlife Code, or possession of a valid hunting license issued by a participating Tribe shall be construed as granting permission to hunt upon the Peoria Tribe's owned or managed lands.

Should the Peoria Tribe elect to open specific properties for hunting in the future, those properties shall be identified in **Appendix A** and approved by official action of the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma. Property-specific regulations may include:

- Permit requirements
- Access restrictions
- Harvest limitations
- Weapon restrictions
- Check-in/check-out requirements
- Area closures
- Other conditions deemed necessary by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma.

The Peoria Tribe reserves the authority to open, close, or otherwise regulate access to any property under its jurisdiction at any time for wildlife management, conservation, habitat restoration, public safety, cultural or ceremonial activities, infrastructure improvements, or other governmental purposes.

SECTION 6

Special Draw Hunts

The Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma may establish special hunting opportunities by official action, including but not limited to:

- Youth Hunts
- Veteran Hunts
- Mobility-Impaired Hunts
- Tribal Citizen Hunts
- Conservation Hunts

Eligibility requirements, application procedures, and hunt regulations shall be established by the Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma before each hunt.

SECTION 7

Cultural Harvest

Nothing contained within these Regulations shall prohibit traditional cultural harvest activities specifically authorized by the Peoria Tribe in accordance with tribal law and applicable federal law.

SECTION 8

Emergency Closures

The Peoria Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma may temporarily suspend or restrict hunting, fishing, trapping, or public access to lands or waters under its jurisdiction whenever necessary to protect:

- Wildlife resources
- Public safety
- Cultural resources
- Natural resources
- Habitat restoration
- Other governmental interests

Emergency closures shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Peoria Tribe.
