



Peoria Powwow 2026 Vendor Space

Basic Terms and Conditions

Contract

This application, properly executed by the applicant (vendor), shall upon written acceptance constitute a valid and binding contract.

Assignment of Space

The assignment of booths by the Peoria Tribe is final and shall constitute an acceptance of the vendor's offer to occupy space. After assignment, space location may not be changed, transferred, or canceled except with the approval of the Peoria Tribe Powwow Vendor Representative. Subletting or licensing of space by the vendor or use of the space not authorized by the Peoria Tribe is prohibited. Booth assignments will be done on a first come basis. Vendors will be permitted to enter the vendor tent for setup starting at/after 12:00pm on Thursday September 25, 2026 only after the vendor fee and contract is received.

Types of Exhibits

Exhibits shall be limited to American Indian arts and crafts and/or designs which are consistent with the theme of the event. Interpretation of the meaning and intent of this restriction shall be the sole prerogative of the Peoria Tribe.

Booth Space Rental Rates

Booth space rental rates will be \$100 for all 3 days (September 25, 26, & 27, 2026). Fees are payable in cash or money order for each spot. Requests for multiple spaces will be accommodated. Vendors are to provide their own tables, chairs, extension cords and other equipment needed to display merchandise.

Payment Requirements

Payment in the form of cash or money order is required with vendor's application. All money orders should be made payable to Peoria Tribe Cultural Preservation Department and mailed to: Peoria Tribe Cultural Preservation Department, PO Box 1527, Miami, OK 74355. Cash payments can be made at tribal headquarters.

Security and Insurance

All property of the vendor is understood to remain under his/her custody and control, in transit to, within, or from the confines of the vendor tent, subject to the rules and regulations of the event. Vendors are advised to carry floater insurance to cover merchandise/material against damage and loss and public liability insurance against injury to the person and property of others. It is recommended that vendors take precautionary measures of their own such as securing small or easily portable articles of value.

Loss or Damage

Vendor agrees the Peoria Tribe will not be liable for any damage or liability of any kind or damage or injury to person(s) or property during the term of this agreement, from any cause whatsoever by reason of use. This includes occupation and enjoyment of exhibit space by vendor or any person thereon with the consent of the vendor, and that vendor will defend, indemnify and save harmless the Peoria Tribe from any liability whatsoever, and account of any such damage, or injury, whether or not caused by negligence of or breach of an obligation by exhibitor or its employees or representatives.

Demonstrations

No demonstrations or solicitations shall be permitted outside the vendor's assigned space, and no signs or placards may be displayed on persons or otherwise outside vendor spaces.

Compliance

The vendor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulations and codes of duly authorized local, state, and federal governing bodies concerning fire, safety, and health, together with the rules and regulations of the event and the Peoria Tribe.

Management

The vendor further agrees that the vendor conditions, rules, and regulations of the 29th Annual Peoria Powwow are made a part of this contract and that said vendor agrees to be bound by each and all rules and regulations, and that the Peoria Tribe shall have the full power to interpret, amend and enforce all rules and regulations in the best interest of the 29th Annual Peoria Powwow.
